 No. 2 was returned on an Application granted to Charles M<sup>c</sup> Coy. No. 1 is erased on the patent being in the fold &c. patented to Philip Smith - the dotted line represents the ground enclosed by the Survey.  
 This land was never in posession of M<sup>c</sup> creery though this is the land he Applied for.
