

Situate in Union Township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 1832 by Virtue of an Order granted to Samuel Shanks dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 2816. Containing two hundred and twenty-six Acres with the usual Allowance of six per cent &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the - day of December 1771 for George Albright in pursuance of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 80. And now owned & occupied by Henry Gross in right of the said George Albright.
