


FORM NO. 1.



Sixty in Union Township Union County Surveyed the 10th day of November 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to John Simpson dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1763. N° 2765. Containing two hundred and twenty-five acres with the usual Allowance of Sixty Centacres.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the day of December 1771 for George Albright in pursuance of his Order dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1763. N° 230. And now owned and occupied by Henry Gross Albright of the said George Albright.
