Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the day of - 1769 for John Potter in pursuance of his Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N. - And now owned and Occupied by Doc. Ard of Lewistown Mifflin County in right of the said John Potter.
