



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed on the 29th day of August 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to Robert Iredell, Sr. dated the 3^d day of April 1769. No. 811. Containing two hundred & Sixteen Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the day of 1769 for John Potter in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. And now owned & occupied by Doc. Ard of Lewistown Pa. (by his tenant) in right of the said John Potter.
