



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County on the branch of Warriors run about five miles from its mouth & at the forks of said run. Surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1835. by virtue of an application dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2635. granted to William Sims containing three hundred and eighteen Acres with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed on the -day of -17- for Albert Maxwell by virtue of his Application dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> of Ap! 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 922. And is now owned and occupied by James Tweed and others in right of said Albert Maxwell.
