



Situate in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 9th day of May 1834. by virtue of an Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 2571. granted to Hamilton Reed. Containing three hundred & fourteen Acres & twenty four perches & the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the 28th day of May 1794 for Owen Foulke in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 21st day of January 1794. Unseated.
