


FORM NO 1.



In pursuance of an Application granted to John Cochran No 2599 dated 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 Surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> of March 1829 the above described tract of land Containing three hundred and forty five acres and three fourth and the allowance proportioned at Six per cent for Roads &c.

situate on the south side of Loyalhanna creek where the White Thorn Run empties into said Creek in the Township of Salem and County of West moreland.

N<sup>o</sup> 2 Was Surveyed and returned for Alexander Craig on a Warrant of March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1803 - Patented N<sup>o</sup> 3 to Samuel Sloan on a Warrant dated July 29<sup>th</sup> 1784 - all patented.
