*Note. - The same tract of land was surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 1775. for Jacob Armbrister in pursuance of two Warrants one dated the 6<sup>th</sup> of August 1773 the other dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1774 & now Occupied by Jacob Houser without title & is Designated by the Yellow lines.*
