



Warrant 18th Jan'y. 1744. granted to Archibald Beard, for 100^{ac} on the South Mountain. ~

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 18th Jan'y. 1744 to Archibald Beard, on lands joining land taken up by Charles Carroll in the South Mountain, situate in Hamiltonbann Town P. Adams County, and have found the Interference as represented in the enclosed Diagram ~ ~ Witness my hand

November 29th 1837. ~
