

Warrant 28<sup>th</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup>. 1746. to George Brennan in Huntington Township. ~ for 50<sup>acres</sup>

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant 28<sup>th</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup>. 1746 to George Brennan for 50<sup>acres</sup> in Huntington Township Adams County, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. ~ Witness my hand. ~
