


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Conewago township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 227^{acres} 47 perches and the usual allowance &c. Located on the 18 day of May 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Connelly for 150^{acres} dated the 12th day of December 1745 and by Virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report. The above is wholly the same Land which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jacob Horse dated the 28th day of October 1754 and Patented to Paul Wildt the 14th day of January 1790 Connelly did own and was in possession of the above Land but Sold his right to Jacob Horse. Now owned and occupied by Michel Wilt and John Wilt.
