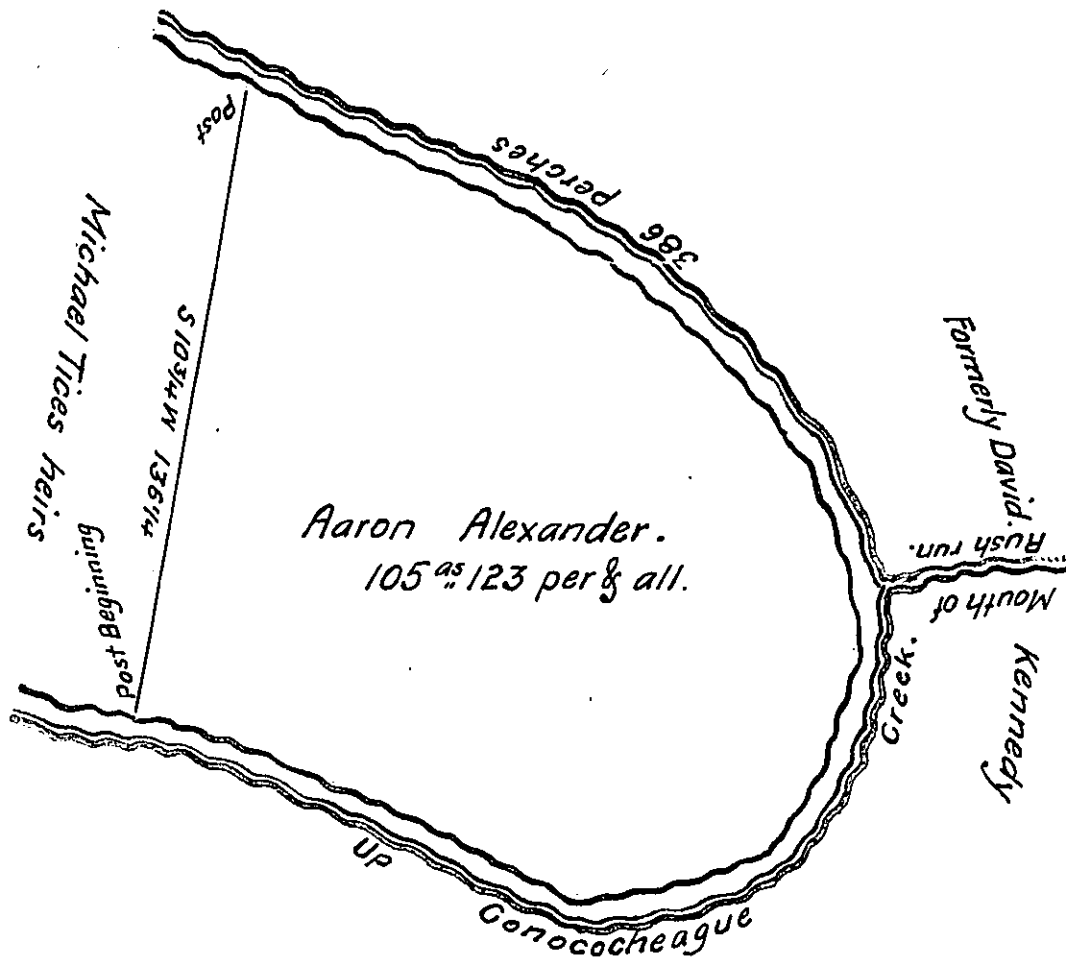

*Draft of a Tract of land Situate in Montgomery township (formerly Hopwell township) Franklin County Containing One Hundred & five Acres One Hundred & twenty three perches & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> of August 1829 (On a Warrant Granted Aaron Alexander for 100<sup>as</sup> of land opposite to a tract of land lately Granted to David Kennedy at the Mouth of Rush Run in Hopewell township dated the 26<sup>th</sup> of April 1742) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for Carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary Rights &c*
