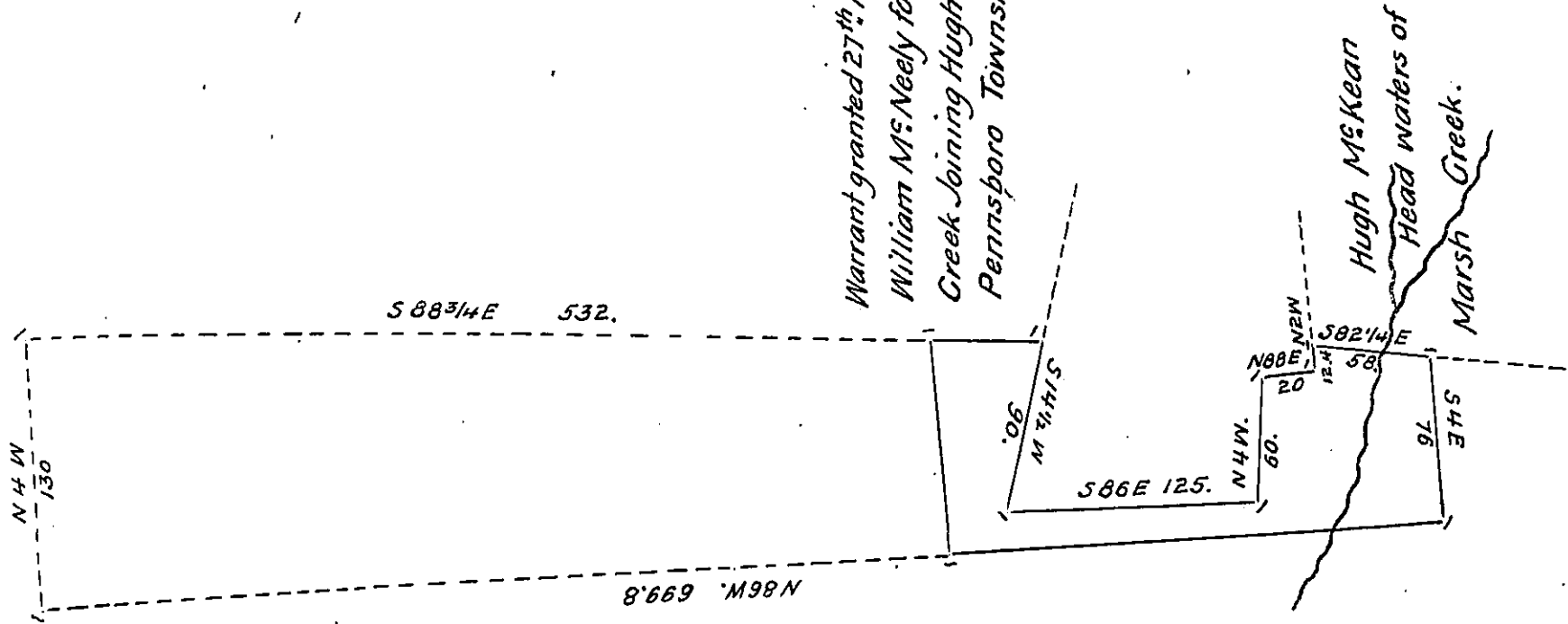

Warrant granted 27th March 1740 to
William M^cNeely for 100^{ac} on Marsh
Creek Joining Hugh M^cKean in
Pennsboro Township.



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant as above granted to William M^cNeely for 100^{ac} in Pennsboro; Township, on Lands situate as aforesaid and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram ~ Witness my hand. ~
