Located on the 23^d day of August 1831. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Armor for 60^{ac} dated the 2^d day of December 1773 and by Virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report. - This Land is now owned and occupied by Peter Smith and is said to be Patented to Benjamin Pedan the 28 of October 1788 but upon what Warrant I am not able to discover. it was also Surveyed and returned on another Warrant of Thomas Armor for 40^{ac} dated 28 November 1771.
