



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 80<sup>as</sup> and allowance &c<sup>a</sup>. Located on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Alexander McGarless for 100<sup>as</sup> dated 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1746. and by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

The above is part of the same Land which was Surveyed on a Warrant of Resurvey dated the 5<sup>th</sup> of March 1768 directing to divide the Land of Alexander McGarless dec<sup>d</sup> according to his Will. It is now owned and occupied by John Neeper to whom a Patent issued for the same dated 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1812
