



Surveyed on the Twenty fifth day of February 1733 To Christian Marree a tract of Land Situate on the East Side of y<sup>e</sup> River Schuylkill in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Begining at a white Oak Standing on the Bank of the S<sup>d</sup> River thence by Vacant land North Seventy Degrees East three hundred & twenty Six fferches to a White Oak thence by Vacant land South Twenty Degrees East one hundred & twenty two fferches to a post thence by land of Moses Goats South Seventy Degrees West three hundred and seventy Two fferches to a Hickry Standing on y<sup>e</sup> Bank of y<sup>e</sup> Said River thence up the Same to y<sup>e</sup> place of Begining Containing Two Hundred and Fifty Acres with Usual Allowance.
