



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing one hundred & forty five acres one hundred & fifty seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 6th of December 1828 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c. and on an application granted John Mortimoth for 50<sup>ac.</sup> of land joining James Rankin the two top Mountain William Watkin & his other land in Peters township dated the 4th of December 1766 No 2074.
