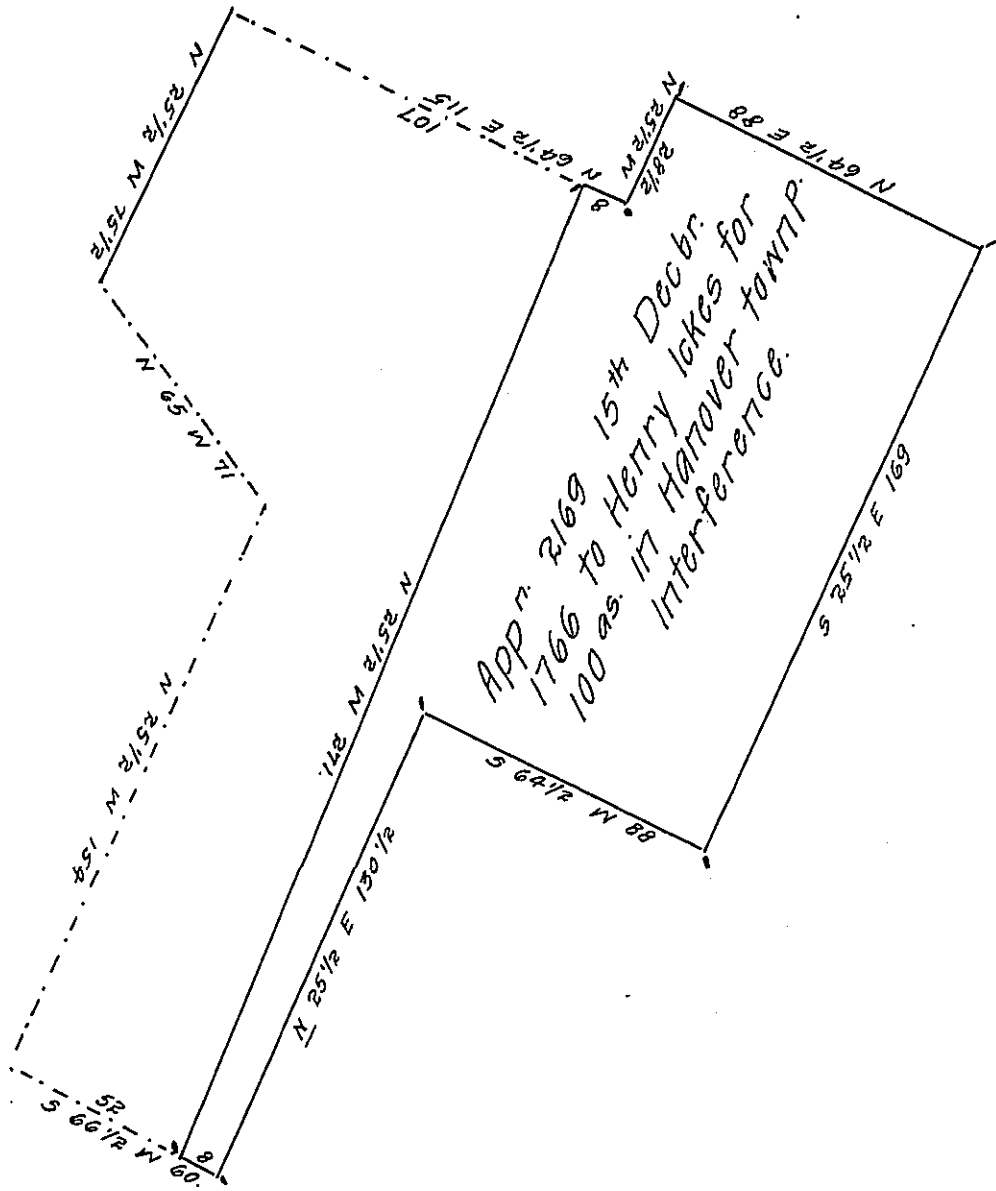


FORM NO 1.



The whole of the above tract is an interference of a tract of 214 1/2 acres of land surveyed to Henry Ickes under a warrant dated 15th December 1766, and patented to Peter Ickes by patent dated 23rd January 1786 enrolled in Pat. Book No. 4 page 348, situate in Berwick township Adams County there being no Hanover township in Adams County, now owned and possessed by Jacob Ernst Esqre. & Jacob Sowers, & others.
