



Situate in Hartley township Union County surveyed May 11th 1836 by virtue of an order granted to Robert McFarland dated the 3^d day of December 1766 & Numbered 2066 containing forty seven acres and the usual allowance & and is designated by the red lines.

Note The same tract of land is included and interferes with a survey made the 17th day of November 1774 for John Glover in pursuance of his warrant dated the 9th day of March 1774 and is represented by Green lines and is now owned by John Glover in right of his Father.
