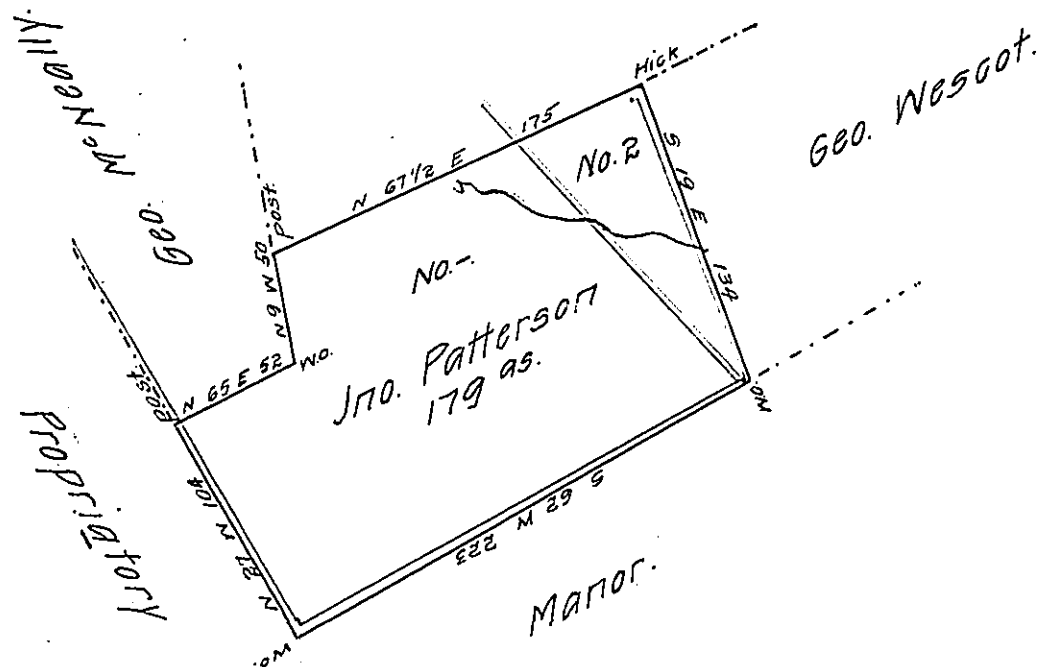


FORM NO 1.



Situate on the waters of Stone Creek joining George McNeally in Barree township Huntingdon County containing one hundred and seventy nine acres and allowance of six per cent for roads surveyed for John Patterson on order No. 1637 dated the 22nd day of October 1766.

The red lines represent part of a survey made for Thomas Mitchemor on warrant dated the 15th day of January 1794. This tract interferes one hundred and fifty seven acres and twenty perches with the John Patterson survey. Thomas Mitchemor conveyed to Gideon H. Wells & Robert Morris who conveyed to John McCahen who conveyed to George McGrumb the present owner.

No. 2. represented by green lines represents part of a survey made for Robert Irwin on warrant dated the 15th day of January 1794

This survey interferes twenty one acres and one hundred & fifty perches with the John Patterson survey. Robert Ervin conveyed to Gideon H.

Wells and Robert Morris who conveyed to John McCahen who conveyed to George McGrumb the present owner.
