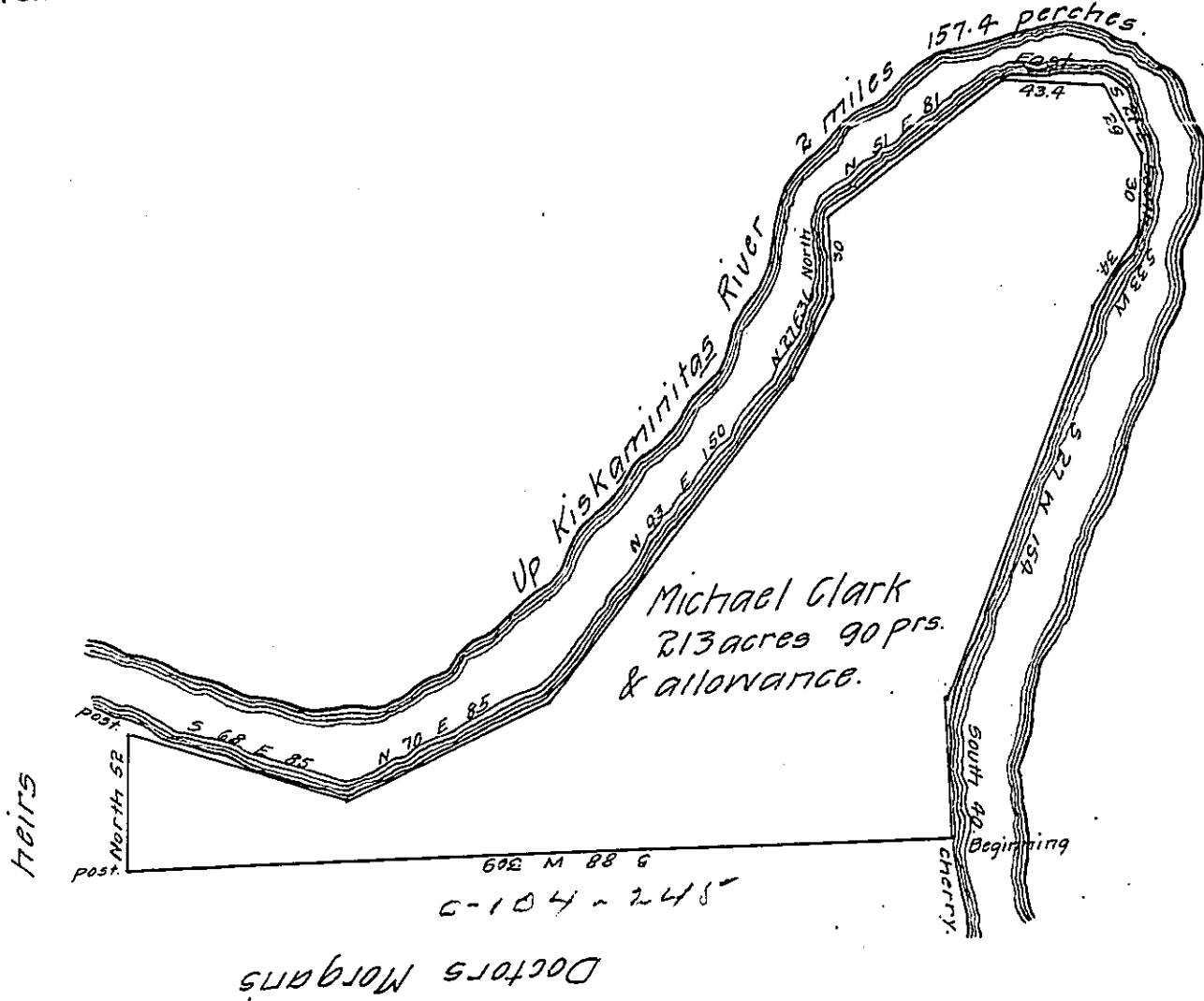


FORM NO 1.

Surveyed on the 11th day of April 1828 the above described tract of land containing two hundred and thirteen acres ninety perches and the allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c. Situate on Kiskiminitas River about 5 miles from the mouth in Allegheny township in the County of Westmoreland.
