



In pursuance of a contract of the first of Nov^r. 1827. with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Penn^a and the authority therein stated, there was surveyed & calculated by virtue of a warrant granted by the Proprietary Government unto John Byrnes the 11th of August 1773, the above tract of land, situate in Plum township Allegheny County, containing Three hundred two acres & thirty four perches & allowance for roads &c.
