



The above described tract was surveyed to John Leasure on the 12th of July 1803 By warrant of the 15th of January 1802. The dotted lines and the letters A. B. C. represent a survey made the 10 of April 1828 to William Bousman a return whereof is herewith enclosed. The land called for by Bousmans warrant is found to lie north of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784 is owned and occupied by John Leasure who claims the land under the title in his own name.
