



The dotted lines and the letters A B in the above diagram represent a survey made to William Fraimer on the 7th of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed the land has been previously surveyed and appropriated by Robert McJemsey Junr. at this time therein stated. It is owned and occupied by Joseph Harbison who claims under the title to McJemsey. I could not ascertain that there was or is any person holding or claiming the land under William Fraimers title.
