



The dotted line and the letters A. B. C. represent a survey made to Baltzer Gull on the 9th of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. It will be seen by the above diagram that the land called for by Gulls warrant ^{has} been previously surveyed and appropriated by James Chain. It is owned and occupied by Samuel Lyons who claims under the title to Chain. I am informed that the title of Gull had not been pursued ~~any executed~~ until after the land was taken by other titles & that no survey was ever made on Gulls warrant until now. It does not appear that any person claims under the title to Baltzer Gull.
