



In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by the authority of the Board of Property I have this 11th day of March 1828 Surveyed the above described tract of Three hundred acres and allowance of six per cent adjoining lands of Mary Graham, George Glentworth, James Glentworth and others. Situate on the west branch of Blacklegs creek in Conemaugh township in the county of Indiana By virtue of a warrant granted to Samuel Meredith the 26th day of March 1776.
