No. 1. represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Archibald Castell the 11th day of April 1797 on warrant dated the 6th day of May 1796, this tract interferes nineteen and one half acres with the Mathew Mease survey Archibald Castell conveyed to Amos Dickens who devised the same to Jonathan Dickens the present owner.
