



The shaded lines in the above diagram represent a survey made to Frederick Stone on the 9th day of April 1828 By warrant of the 25th of Jan. 1774. The land called for by Stones warrant is found to lie North of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784 and is included within ~~the~~ a survey made to Jan. Linklean and Herman Leroy ^{at} the time therein stated which survey is represented by the dotted lines on the above diagram. The survey of Stone is in the occupancy of Mathew Steel who claims under the title to Herman Leroy & Jan Linklean No. 3249. This diagram is accompanied by a return of the survey on Fred.^k Stones warrant but not claimed by any one under his title that I can find.
