



Application 2335 14th Jan^y 1767 to Richard Baird for 50 acres, on Middle Creek in the Mountain in Hamiltonbanⁿ township.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Application 2335, granted 14th Jan^y 1767 to Richard Baird for 50 acres of land in Hamiltonbanⁿ township, on lands situate in Hamiltonbanⁿ-Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
