Situate on the South Side of the Raystown Branch of Juni-
 atta opposite the mouth of Coffee Run in Hopewell Township,
 Huntingdon County. Containing three hundred ninety and one
 half acres and allowance of six percent for roads. Surveyed the
 16th day of June 1787, for Jacob Johnston on order No. 5298,
 dated the 12th. december 1768.

The dotted and black lines represent ~~the~~ a survey made
 for John Welsh on order No. 631 dated the 1st of August 1766.
 This survey interferes two hundred fifteen and one half acres
 with the Jacob Johnston tract. John Welsh conveyed to John
 Lutrens Esqr who devised the same to his heirs. John Lutrens'
 Executors abandoned all claim to this tract of land.
