

Matthews late D.S. in pursuance of Samuel Smith's Application No. 5396 for 100as dated the 27th of March 1769 and now this 25 day of May 1831, the same is returned by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property. Report. This land is included in a survey of 258⁷/₈ as made on a warrant granted to Samuel Smith for 80as dated the 18th of August 1786 and patented to Charles Waltermeyer the 6th of September 1805 who at present own and occupies the whole. I examined his papers and altho, his draft made on his warrant in the certificate is mentioned that it includes two old surveys, yet I could not determine upon which part this was located, as it did not touch on any of the outside lines
