



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 159 as and the usual allowance &c. Located on the 7 day of June 1831 in persuance of Hugh Dorans application No. 5382 for 150as dated 27 March 1769 & by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property. Report. The above is the same land which was surveyed by Wm. Matthews in persuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Hawkins dated the 1st of April, 1751, and patented to John Doran on the 28 of August 1809. Now owned by Bennet Doran living in the State of Maryland and occupied by Jesse Ward. — Hawkins warrant had been located on some other land, surveys of which are filed in the land office.
