



The above draught describes a tract of land situate in Tyrone Township Perry County and contains as follows viz; No 1, contains 112 a. 116 p & allowance. Surveyed May 23d, 1790 in pursuance of a warrant granted Lettice Alexander for 100a dated June 24th, 1789. No. 2, surveyed October the 17th, 1796 on a warrant to Lettice Alexander dated August 3d, 1793, and contains 78 a. 85 p.

Resurveyed as above February the 28th 1833 and contains in all one hundred ninety one acres 32 p & allowance. Resurveyed on an Order granted John Young for 200a dated 27th December 1768, No. 5304 and now owned by Philip Fusselman.
