



Draught of a tract of land situate in Conewago (late Newberry) township in the County of York containing within the black lines 265 acres & the usual allowance &c. Surveyed on the 17th day of May 1831, in pursuance of Frederick Hershfield's application No. 5146 for 300as dated the 27th day of August 1768 and in pursuance of the contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report. The part marked A containing 50a 21 perches &c was surveyed on a warrant granted to Adam Miller dated 15 October 1766 and patented to George Miller the 18 of January 1809 now owned and occupied by George Firtt Senr. The other part marked B, was surveyed on the 7 day of September, 1786, on a warrant granted to Andrew Miller dated 13th of April, 1786, and said to be patented to him on this warrant. Owned and occupied by George Firtt, Senr, Daniel & Frederick Miller & Peter Zorger. The dotted lines represent the balance of survey on Andrew Millers warrant. It is not known that Hershfield ever was in possession of any of the above land. Danl Small And W Miller Patd.
