 cation No. 5519 dated 14th June 1769 granted to Peter Weil for 130a and also in per-
 suance of the contract entered into with the Board of Property.
 Report. Letter A, contains 26as and is embraced in a patent granted to Paul
 Wildt on a warrant in the name of Jacob Horse dated the 28 of October 1754
 owned and occupied by Michel Wildt. The part B containing 19as &c^a was
 patented to George Auchenbach the 10 of December, 1821, on Baltzer
 Knertzers application No. 2878, dated the 24th day of February 1767, and
 is now owned and occupied by John Auchenbach and George New-
 man. The part C contains 46as 25 ps. &c. and is owned and occu-
 pied by John Auchenbach and patented the 10th December, 1821, to George
 Auchenbach on another application of Peter Weils No. 2855 dated the
 23^d of February 1767.
