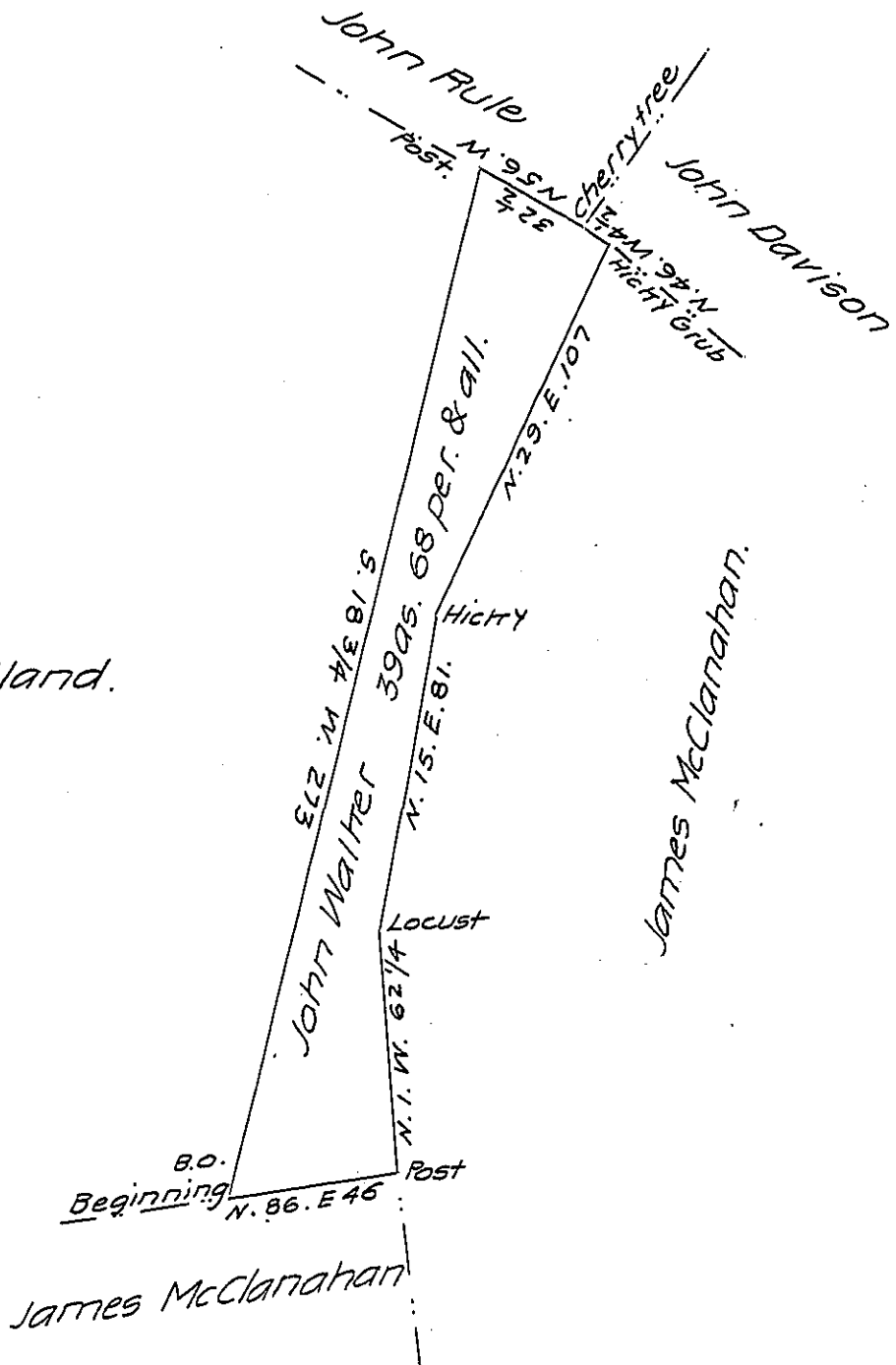


John McClelland.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Antrim Township Franklin County containing thirty nine acres, sixty eight perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. which was surveyed in pursuance of an Application granted John Walter for 200as of land. Joining John Davison, James McClanahan & John McClelland, in Antrim township, dated the 23d of June, 1768, No. 5064, as appears from a rough draft in the Deputy Surveyors office of Franklin County. Certified the 11th of March 1830 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.
