Note. Find in the office an old draft including the above; together with the dotted figure marked A. on which were endorsed the following words "Sur-

vey^d. for ~~Samuel~~^{Alexander} Culbertson, 6th June 1769, on a warrant of 50 acres dated 25 Oct^r 1753 and on an order of 200 acres in his own name, not come to hand. This is the only evidence that leads to the above location. together with the order calling for Robert Culbertsons line. Note further. The dotted figure A. is held on a warrant dated 25 Oct^r 1753.
