Report The part A. containing 51<sup>as.</sup> 89 perches was surveyed and returned in pursuance of Lewis Lewis application No. 1147 dated 8 September 1766 and is now owned and occupied by Gasper Lichtenberger Paul Yinger John Wilt and John Schroll. The part B. containing 9<sup>as.</sup> 124 perches was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry King for 10<sup>as.</sup> dated 27 June 1803 now Michael Grabill Henry King not paid } Dan<sup>r</sup> Small.
