These are to will and require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye same w<sup>th</sup> in ye Bounds thereof, & make returns of it into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 6<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo 1684.
