These are to will & require thee forth wth to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye afore mention'd County on the ^{other} side of Christopher Taylor's, where not taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 26th 8th 1683.
