*At the Request of David Brintnal that We would Grant him to take up the Proportion of Liberty Land belonging to the Original purchase of two hundred & fifty Acres made of the Proprietary by Alexander Mell by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 31 day of March & ye first day of April Anno. 1682. The Right to the whole being now Vested in the said David. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said David Brintnal in the said Liberties the Said Proportion of Liberty Land if there to be found Vacant and clear of all former Surveys and make exact Returns there of into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation. Given under our Hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December Anno. Din. 1719.*
