I hereby Certify that I have Surveyd ye 26th of ye 3^d mo. 1702. unto John Bale a Certain peec of Land in ye Libarty of ye City of Philladelphia one the West sid of Scoolkeel - beginneing at a Corner Red ok being A Corner of John Thomas Land from thenc by a Line of Marked trees & Vaccant Land North 40 perches to a black ok Saplin marked from thenc by a Line of Marked trees East 80 perches to a stak Set in ye ground by Harford Roade from thenc by a Line of Marked trees South 40 perches to a stak Set in ye ground in a Line of John Thomas Land from thenc by ye Line of Marked trees and Same Land West 80 perches to ye place of beginneing Containeing & Laid out for 20 acres of Land and is according to ye bounds above described Returnd into the Generall Survey^rs Office at Philladelphia ye 26^d day of ye 4th mo 1702.
