Joⁿ Bristow one of the Executors of S^d Brasie hath requested us to grant ~~the~~ another to Same Effect. These are therefore in ye Proprietarys Name to will and Require thee forthwith to Survey or Cause to be Surveyd ye said peece of Land as aforesaid and make Returne there off to ye Secretarys Office Dated at Philad. ye 3^d day of ye First month 1690 =
