By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Andrew Bradford of Philadelphia that We would Grant him to take up & inclose the West and North parts of a Square of ground between the ninth & tenth Streets from the River Delaware & between High Street & Mulberry Street in Philadelphia aforesaid and that He may Hold the same for the Term of one & Twenty Years under the Yearly Rent of six & Twenty Shillings & eight pence Sterling Money of Great Britain which He agrees to pay to the Proprietary or Trustees of the Province and to deliver up ye same at ye expiration of ye said Term under a good fence & well improved. These are to Authorize & require thee to Survey & layout unto ye said Andrew Bradford the West & North parts of the aforesaid Square of Ground to contain the Northern half thereof & one third part of ye other half. To be by him Held under ye said Yearly rent of six & twenty Shillings & eight pence Sterling for & during ye said Term of one & Twenty Years from ye date hereof which in case ye said ~~Thomas Straker~~ Andrew Bradford duly & Yearly pay & Perform ye above agreement. Then the Survey to be made by Vertue hereof shall be for ye said Term Valid. otherwise ye same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our Hands & ye lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia ye first day of ye first Month Anno Din. 17¹⁹/₂₀.
