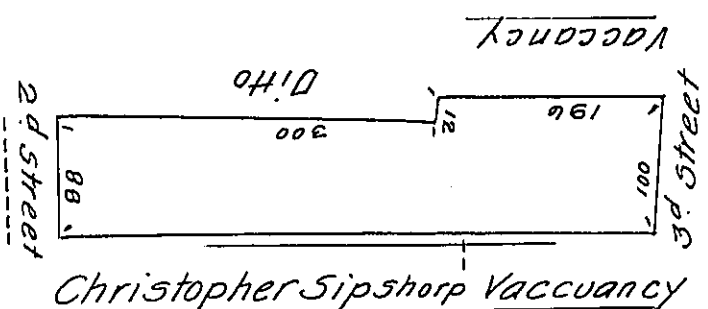
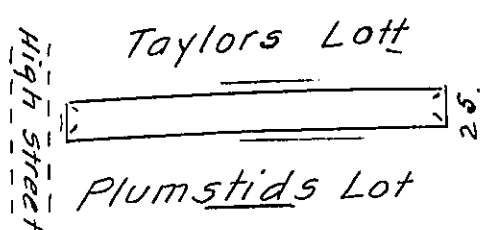

Last I do Certify y^t I have Surveyd unto Matthias Van Bebber in Right of his Father Jaccob Van Bebber a Certain peece of ground in Philladelphia bound one the South With ye High Street and one East with Francis Plumsted's Lot. and one ye North With ye New graveyard and one ye West With Reputed Christopher Taylors Lot. ~~being~~ Containing in Length 306 feet and in breadth 27 feet. and also another peece of ground bounded one the East With ye 2^d Street from Delaware and one ye North With Christopher Sipshorps Lot. and With Vacuancy and one ye West With 3^d Street and one ye South With a Reputed Vacancy by a Line East 18 degrees South 196 feet. Thence E. 72 degrees North 12 feet. thence East 18 degrees South 300 feet to the said 2^d Street.
