

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary & Gov. bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of 8: 1701 for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes. Survey'd and laid out the 28<sup>th</sup> day of ye 5<sup>m<sup>o</sup></sup> 1704. unto Andrew Bankston five hundred acres of land on the East side of Schuylkill—in the County of Philad<sup>ia</sup>. Beginning at a post by Schuylkill—at the Corner of Peter Cock's land then by said land North twenty degrees East one thousand one hundred and ten perch<sup>s</sup> to a post Then East South east Seventy perches & a <sup>half</sup> to a post. Then by the line of John Cock's land South twenty degrees west one hundred and sixty perches to a post by Schuylkil River. Then up the same on the Courses there of to the place of Beginning.
