

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary & Gov. bearing date the 21st day of 8: 1701 for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes. Survey'd and laid out the 28th day of ye 5^{m^o} 1704. unto Andrew Bankston five hundred acres of land on the East Side of Schuylkill—in the County of Philad^{ia}. Beginning at a post by Schuylkill—at the Corner of Peter Cock's land then by said land North twenty degrees East One Thousand one hundred and ten perch^s to a post Then East South east Seventy perches & a ^{half} to a post. Then by the line of John Cock's land South twenty degrees west one hundred and sixty perches to a post by Schuylkil River. Then up the same on the Courses there of to the place of Beginning.
