

By Vertue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 8<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1703.

Surveyd unto Adam Burch five hundred acres of land where on he now dwelleth. Scituate on Schuylkil—beginning at a birch tree by the Said River Schoolkil and Extending North east three hundred and twenty four perches to a white oak from thence south east two hundred forty two perches to a black oak. Thence south west three hundred and ninety six perches to a dead white oak by the said Schuylkil—Then up the the same on several Courses two hundred and eighty two per. and a half to the beginning. Surveyd and layd out by John Andrews the 15<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1703.
