him fourteen foot more adjoyning to his Lott of thirty six  
foot, <sup>to make it up fifty feet.</sup> in front & in ye Length answerable. & make returns  
thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia  
ye 29<sup>th</sup> of ye 12 mo. 16 83.
